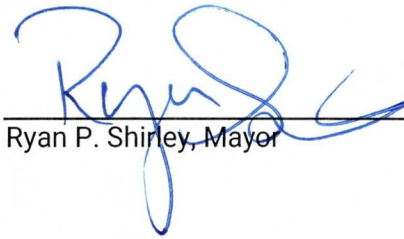
X. ADJOURNMENT
