August 1, 2022

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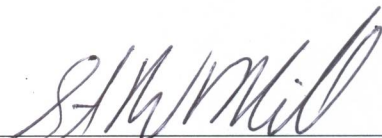
Mayor Miller called the Special Called meeting to order.
